



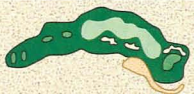
1 A very reachable par 5 as long as tee shot finds fairway. An elevated green surrounded by water makes accuracy and distance a must.

2 The premium here is put on the second shot. Short right is not an option.



3 A long dogleg left. Play to right side of fairway off the tee. A shot to the left is blocked out from the green. A good drive still leaves another testing long iron into the green.

4 Short par 4. Long hitters can cut corner 180 yards from Gold tee to carry bunker. Multi-tiered green makes correct club selection for second shot a must.



5 An elevated tee offers a clear view of the green. Play to opening on right side.

6 Tee shot in fairway a must. Landing area from Gold tee is 150 yards. Short iron second shot to an elevated green sloped back to front.



7 Only 170 yards to water from Gold tee. A long iron or utility is the play from tee to give you a short iron for second shot.

8 Great par 3. Short is not an option. Take one more club. Green severely sloped back to front.



9 Dogleg left around fairway bunker. Play to right side of fairway to have a clear second shot. 240 yards to carry bunker from Gold tee.

**10**  Split the two lakes off the tee and have a short to mid-iron shot into a very narrow green. Green is only 12 yards deep.


---

**11**  A well bunkered green makes club selection essential. Short is an option when trying to make your par.


---

**12**  A reachable par 5 for long hitters. Water surrounds this elevated double tiered green which makes for a tough save. A birdie is here for the taking.

**13**  215 yards to bunker in fairway from the Gold tee. Layup leaves a short iron to blind green.



**14**  Club selection is paramount on this water framed golf hole. A severe back to front green slope.


---

**15**  Difficult driving hole. Water right and trees left. A good drive still leaves the player with a long iron or wood into a double tiered green. Short left is the play with second shot to have a chance at saving par.


---

**16**  Cut off as much as you can. 210 yards to carry left side or water from Gold tee. Water runs down left side of fairway and comes into play on second shot. Three tiered green.

---

**17**  The premium here is put on the second shot. An island green makes club selection crucial. A layup may be the correct play.

---

**18**  A fairway bunker on right side makes drive down left side a must. Front bunker is 20 yards short of green. Don't be fooled by distance. If pin is in back use extra club to get over first tier in green.
