PLEASE NOTE: THERE ARE 5 PIN POSITIONS WHICH VARY FROM DAY TO DAY.
THE STARTER WILL INFORM YOU OF WHICH 'NUMBER' WILL BE USED ON EACH GIVEN DAY

ALL FAIRWAY YARDAGES ARE TO THE MIDDLE OF THE GREENS



Local Rules

- 1. Out of Bounds** (Rule 27)
Out of Bounds is beyond white posts, fences, or walls bounding the course.
- 2. Immovable Obstruction** (Rule 24)
All artificially surfaced roads, tracks and paths including those with a prepared earth surface are immovable obstructions.
- 3. Stones in Bunkers**
Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions. (Rule 24-1).
- 4. Integral Parts of the Course**
The stone wall to the right of the 8th hole.
- 5. Fixed Sprinkler Heads**
All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if a ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and such an obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief as follows: The ball shall be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids such intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green. The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.
PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE:
Match play - Loss of hole; Stroke play - Two strokes.

All rakes are to be placed in bunkers.
