## LOCAL RULES

- To assist with our Pace of Play, if a player's ball is lost in the native or desert areas surrounding the golf course, the player may drop another ball within two club-lengths from the point of entry, no nearer the hole. One Stroke penalty.
- Drop Areas are located on the green side of holes 3,7 and I7. If a ball is in or it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has or has not been found is in the water hazard or wash, the player may: Proceed under Rule 26 or as an additional option, drop a ball, under penalty of one stroke, in the dropping zone.
- Please keep golf carts on the path on all par 3's and at least 30 yards from all greens and tees.
- Golf Carts may not be driven in the native grass or desert areas.
- Appropriate golf attire must be worn at all times.


## USGA RULES

- Water Hazard are defined by yellow stakes or lines and the player may proceed under Rule 26-I.
- Lateral Water Hazard are defined by red stakes or lines and the player may proceed under Rule 26-I with additional options 26-Ic.
- Out of Bounds are defined by white stakes or lines, perimeter fences and roadways and the player my proceed under Rule 27-Ib.
- Golfers are responsible for any damage due to an errant golf shot.
